Survey of Current Civil Legal Services to be Issued

The Access to Justice Commission's Committee on Maximizing the Use of Available Resources is seeking your assistance. The Committee is tasked with looking at the current available resources and finding ways to maximize the use of these resources to best deliver civil legal services to the low- and moderate-income.

The first task of the committee is to take a survey of the current civil legal services that are being provided to the community. There is currently no comprehensive centralized information on all of the programs provided by civil legal service providers in Hawai'i. Information is available through links on both the Hawai'i State Bar Association and Judiciary websites, but critical information to determine the best ways to make use of their collective resources is currently unavailable.

In July, legal service providers, mediation centers and other organizations across the state will be receiving a detailed survey to help gather this information. The Committee on Maximizing the Use of Available Resources is asking those attorneys who may be working with legal service providers, mediation centers, and other organizations that are providing civil legal services to be clear and honest in answering the survey so that limited resources can be maximized to meet the legal needs in the community.
