

Aloha State Stories:  
Promise of Justice for All  
**VIDEO CONTEST  
Entry Form**

**Grand Prize \$1,500  
Open to All Hawaii Residents  
Deadline: July 9, 2008**

The Hawaii State Bar Association invites Participants to create a video about the promise of justice for all. The HSBA will select a grand prize winner from the videos submitted. The winner will receive a prize of \$1,500.

1. To enter, please complete and sign this entry form and agree to the terms of these rules. This video contest is sponsored by the Hawaii State Bar Association ("HSBA"). Videos must be submitted in a DVD format.
  2. All videos must be **received** by the HSBA on or before July 9, 2008. You may hand-deliver or mail your video to the Hawaii State Bar Association, 1132 Bishop Street, Suite 906, Attention: Tammy Takara. If you mail your entry, please make sure that it reaches the HSBA on or before July 9, 2008.
  3. All videos must be two minutes long or less.
  4. If you are under the age of 18, your parent or legal guardian must sign this entry form.
  5. Participant agrees to the terms and rules of this contest. This contest is open to all residents of Hawaii. Persons under 18 years must receive their parent's permission and provide written parental consent before their entries are considered. HSBA employees, HSBA directors, and their family members are not eligible.
  6. A panel of judges will be chosen to select the grand prize winner. Winning is contingent on fulfilling all the requirements. Winners may be required to provide proof, including proof of age and residency requirements.
  7. Each Participant may enter the contest only once.
  8. Entry videos become the exclusive property of the HSBA and will not be acknowledged or returned.
  9. The Participant must not have granted any person or entity other than the HSBA the right to use the video.
  10. Submitted videos will not be accepted or eligible if they include any content that contains or appears to contain (a) profane or obscene material; (b) endorsement of (or condones) illegal drug use, alcohol abuse, or other illegal activity; (c) nudity, profanity, or violence; (d) any express or implied commercial endorsement; (e) any derogatory characterization of any person or group based on age, race, color, gender, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, religious beliefs, marital status, mental or physical disability, citizenship, creed, national origin, physical appearance, political affiliation, union membership, or other unethical, distasteful, or unlawful factors; or (f) any conduct, language, or other context deemed inappropriate by the HSBA or any of the judges.
  11. Participant is solely responsible for obtaining, and has obtained, from all applicable individuals or entities any and all required rights, releases, consents, clearances, licenses, and other authorization (collectively referred to as "Releases") necessary to use the video, without monetary compensation, in any and all media, including, but not limited to the following: (a) location releases; (b) releases from any person whose name, voice, likeness, or persona is referenced, shown, or otherwise used in the video; and (c) signatures of the Participant's parent or legal guardian if any of the individuals in the video are under the age of majority. Participant assigns the Releases to the HSBA and agrees to provide them to the HSBA.
  12. By submitting a video, the Participant agrees and warrants that the video and all elements contained therein does not infringe on any copyright owned by another and that the content of the video is within the bounds of the fair use doctrine.
  13. The HSBA reserves the right (but not the obligation) to verify that all necessary clearances have been obtained, prior to selecting the video as the grand prize winner. The HSBA may disqualify any submitted video at any time if the Participant has not obtained all necessary releases or for not fulfilling the requirements herein.
  14. By entering, Participant releases and agrees to defend and to indemnify the HSBA and HSBA's sponsors, subsidiaries, affiliates, directors, officers, employees, and agents from any all liability for any claims, injuries, loss, or damage of any kind arising from or in connection with the video, the contest, the fundraising event, and/or the receipt, use, or misuse of the prize.
  15. Participant agrees that the HSBA may retain the submitted video and releases the HSBA from liability for any loss or damage thereto. Participant grants to the HSBA the right, license, and permission to reproduce, edit, adapt, modify, disseminate, distribute, perform, display the video in any audio or audiovisual format, including without limitation, DVD, CD, video, audio tape, digital audio transmission, download, web cast, podcast, broadcast, and/or telecast, whether digital or analog, anywhere in the world. Participant represents to the HSBA that all materials are original, do not infringe upon or otherwise implicate any third party rights, and that Participant has full right and authority to grant the rights, licenses, and permissions being granted to the HSBA herein. This grant is given without monetary consideration. Participant understands and agrees that the HSBA may receive revenues from the video and that Participant shall have no rights to share in any of these proceeds.
  16. Participant grants to the HSBA the unqualified, unrestricted, worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual, and royalty-free right to use his or her name, logo, marks, or other distinctive identification in connection with promoting or marketing the contest or its theme and in future materials for attorneys or the public.
  17. The rights described herein begin immediately upon submission of the video. The HSBA has no obligation to post or display any submitted video and may at its discretion remove any submitted video at any time.
  18. The contest is governed by the laws of the State of Hawaii, and Participant consents to its exclusive jurisdiction for any causes or controversies therefrom.
  19. The HSBA reserves the right to void entries it deems associated with electronic or non-electronic tampering. Should technical difficulties arise that comprise the integrity of the contest, the HSBA may cancel, modify, or suspend the contest without notice. In that case, the HSBA reserves the right (but not the obligation) to award the prize from eligible entries received before cancellation.
  20. The HSBA is not responsible for any technical malfunction or service outage related to the contest.
