**THE CORPORATE LAWYERS' NIGHTMARE: REPRESENTING TROUBLED ORGANIZATIONAL CLIENTS**

Law firms are under a growing threat of claims by third parties for injuries arising when corporate clients collapse, in circumstances where the lawyers are alleged to have contributed to the damage. Various theories for these claims are advanced, but most involve the charge of aiding and abetting the breach of a fiduciary duty allegedly owed to the third party, or some closely analogous theory. The program will review the state of the developing case law, and will show that in some circumstances plaintiffs are succeeding in obtaining awards or forcing settlements. The program will then focus on the steps that law firms can take to avoid this kind of exposure and possible liability.
